Pop-up

About NAVFone



NAVFone Pro is an intelligent street directory, which allows you to display comprehensive maps on your mobile phone. With the connection to a GPS receiver, Navfone Pro will provide turn by turn, voice guided navigation.

The main window in **NAVFone Pro** is the map window. Located at the bottom of the screen are the zoom in/out buttons and the menu to access the various features of **NAVFone Pro**. Tap & hold on the map window will enable the pop-up of the map menu. Favourites, with text labels, can be created to mark specific positions of interest on the map. Map features can be located through a simple query by keyword, after which, they are reflected in the map window. The proprietary GPRX technology which enables self-locate and location query of another mobile device can be found at “Where is...” of the **NAVFone Pro** menu.

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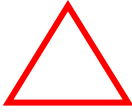

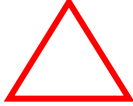

1. Getting Started

The NAVFone Pro is an advanced and intelligent information system that harnesses the cutting edge technology of GPRX (cell-based location engine) and Geographical Information System (GIS) to provide detailed street level map information and LBS (Location Based Services). When connected to a GPS receiver via Bluetooth, Navfone Pro is able to provide street level turn-by-turn voice-guided navigation.

NAVFone Pro is developed for Symbian Platform.

1.1 What are the system requirements?

- Mobile Devices
 - Symbian UIQ 3 (i.e. SonyEricsson M600i & P990i)
 - Memory size of about
 - ◆ Application 1MB

 - ◆ Malaysia 12MB

- Desktop or laptop

1.2 Installing NAVFone

Software serial number can be purchased online at www.asiagis.com.sg

- **SMS registration**
 1. Download SIS installer from the website.
 2. Transfer the SIS installer into the compatible mobile device.
 3. Run the installer on the mobile device.
 4. When you try to initiate the application, you will encounter 2 options in the order listed below.
 - Activate Software
 - Prepaid

Step 1: Prepaid

1. Select “Prepaid” and tap OK.
2. Enter the registration/serial number, select “Ok”.
3. Wait for a confirmation SMS which will contain the activation details.

Step 2: Activate Software

1. After receiving the confirmation SMS, select “Activate Software” and tap OK.
2. Enter the registration/serial number & activation code provided in the SMS.
3. Finally, initiate the application again and you should be able to access the application seamlessly.

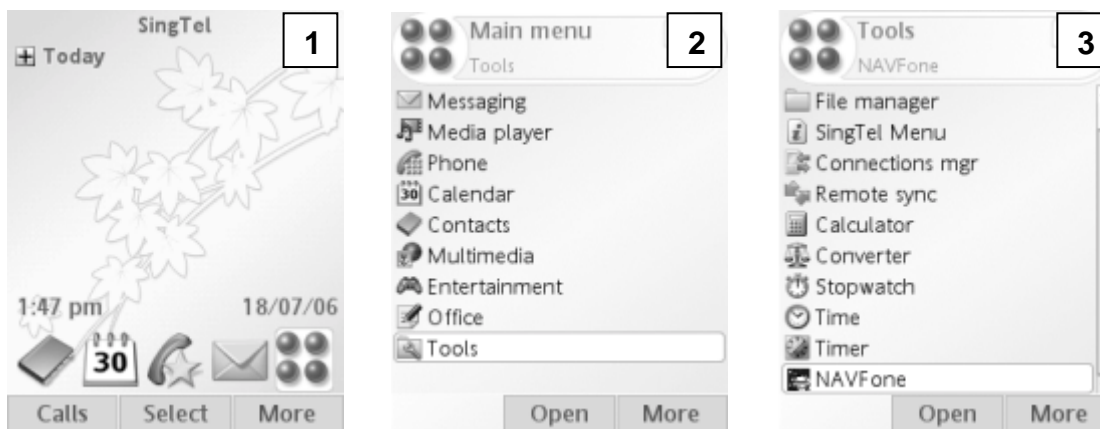
Now that you have installed NAVFone Pro on your mobile device, you are ready to go.

1. Tap phone's **Menu** 
2. Tap **Tools**
3. Tap **Navfone Pro** to begin.



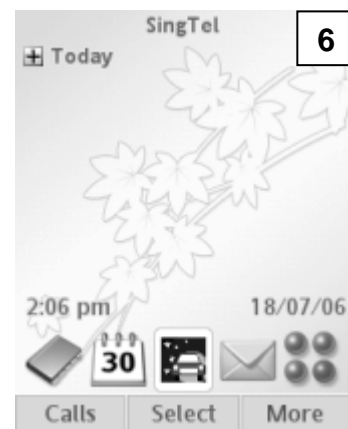
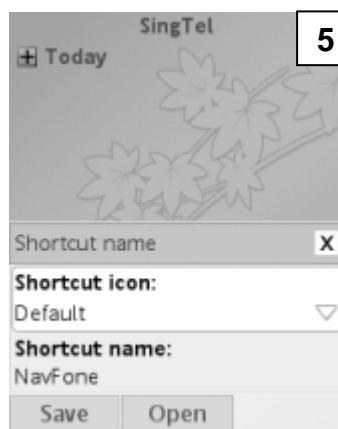
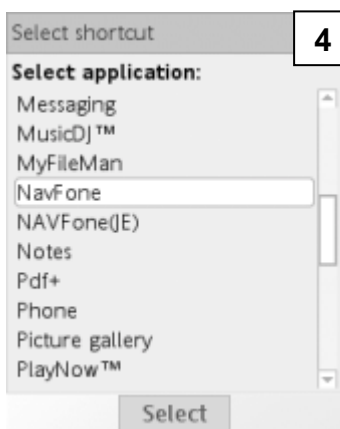
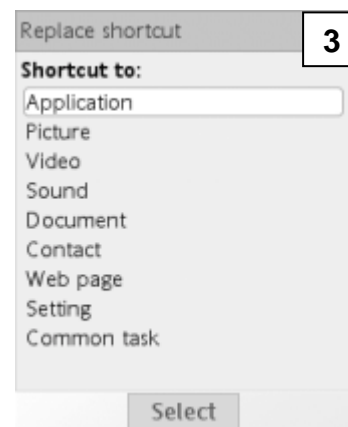
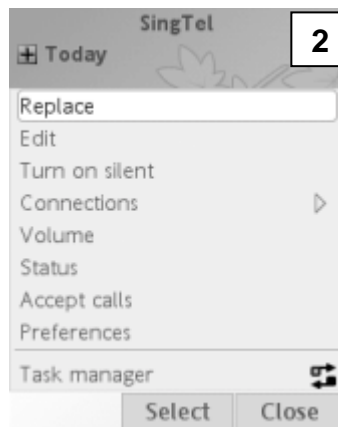
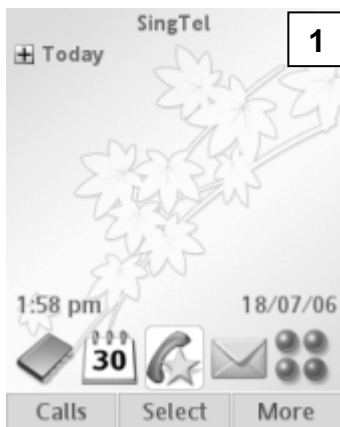

- **Creating Shortcut**

To facilitate quicker access to the application, you may create a shortcut to Navfone at the default front screen of the phone.

- 1 Select one of the existing shortcuts to be replaced.
- 2-4 Tap **More > Replace > Application > Navfone Pro.**
- 5 Tap **Save.**
- 6 Shortcut created!





- **Navfone**

Navfone default startup is the map view. At map view, you can perform all the map functions listed the below.



Map view

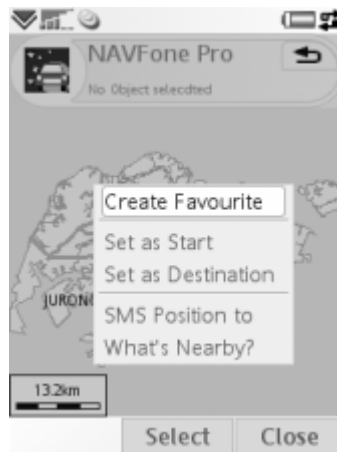

- **Navfone > Map Menu**

At Map view, perform a tap & hold for about 2 seconds. You will see a pop-up map menu as shown in the picture below.



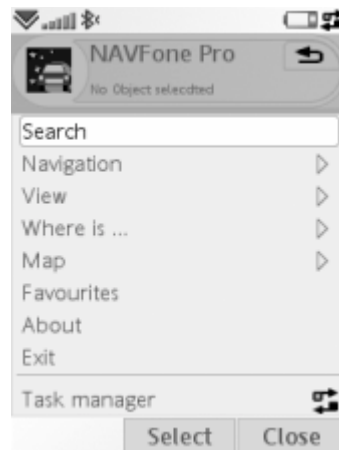

- **Navfone > More**

At map view, tap **More** to access functions as shown below.

2.2 Search

There are two types of search, namely;

- Search (keyword search)
- What's nearby (proximity search)

- **Search (by keyword)**

Query a location or map feature.

1. Tap **More > Search** button.
2. Select the layer that you want to query from the scroll list.
(To search all map layers, select **More > Mark All**)
3. Enter a keyword in the text box.
4. Tap **Search** button.
5. The search result will be listed in the text area at the bottom of the screen.
(If there is no result, there will be a message "Sorry, No item found".)
6. Highlight the desired item from the result list.
7. To create a favourite at the selected location, tap **More > Create favourite**.
8. To do a proximity search around the vicinity of the selected location as a target for navigation, tap **More > What's Nearby**.
9. To share the selected location with another Navfone user, tap **More > Send Position**.
10. To plan a route using selected location as the start or destination, tap **More > Set as Start/Destination**.
11. Alternatively, to view the item selected in Step 5 on the map, tap the **Map** button.

Note:

Maximum number of items to be displayed under the search result is limited to 100 records.

- **What's Nearby (by proximity)**

Allow the user to search for map items in the vicinity of the current screen location.

1. From either one of the method listed below, select **What's Nearby**.
2. Select one or more type of **Map layers** to search for by checking the checkbox at the **Map layers**.
3. Tap **Search** to start searching.
4. The result of the search will be listed.
(If no result is found, the list will be empty.)
5. To view an item on the map, tap the item to select it, then tap the **Map** button to go to the map view.
6. To create a favourite at the selected location, tap **More > Create favourite**.
7. To do a proximity search around the vicinity of the selected location, tap **More > What's Nearby**.
8. To share the selected location with another Navfone user, tap **More > Send Position**.
9. To plan a route using selected location as the start or destination, tap **More > Set as Start/Destination**.

There are two methods to do a "What's Nearby".

Method 1:

At map view, tap and hold on a particular location on the map for about 2 seconds. A map menu will pop-up with the option to do a "What's Nearby".

Method 2:

Immediately after a search result has been displayed, select an item and tap **More**. There will be an option to do a "What's Nearby"

Note:

Maximum number of items to be displayed under the search result is limited to 100 records with a maximum range of 1000m in radius.

2.3 Navigation

Navfone Pro has comprehensive road data and is capable of providing turn by turn, voice guided navigation when connected to a GPS receiver. Even without a GPS receiver, you can also plan a route to your destination and do a simulation using the playback function.

- **Connect GPS**

Connect to a Bluetooth GPS receiver.

1. Tap **More > Navigation > Connect GPS**
2. If Bluetooth not turned on, you will be prompted to enable Bluetooth. Select "Yes".
3. Select the GPS receiver from a list of Bluetooth devices found in the vicinity.
4. Once connected successfully, you will see an arrow indicating your current location on the map.

- **Clear Route**

Clear the previous route created.

Clear route is only required if you wish to re-plan a route from the map menu. When the previous route is not cleared, you will not be able to select a Start or Destination from the menu.

- **Play Route**

Simulation of the traveling on the planned route.

- **Centre at GPS**

Keeps the GPS location at the centre of map. By default, this is turned on when GPS is connected. You should turn it off to pan the map to other location while still connected to GPS.

View the entire map extent.

2.5 Where is ...

Thanks to our proprietary GPRX technology, Navfone is able to detect and display its current position on the map without the assistance of additional device such as a GPS receiver. Not only that, it can even locate other Navfone user(s) via the **Where are U** function.

GPRX is a proprietary improved GSM tracking engine that is Telco-independent and it has a highly improved accuracy.

Typical accuracy in city (< 100m)

Suburban (<200m)

Remote (200m onwards)

- **Where am I**

Self detect and display current position on the map. Location is represented by a semi-transparent circle. No SMS is required.

5. Tap **More > Where is ...**
6. Tick the checkbox at **Where am I**
7. During a cold start, it will take a while for the position to be detected. And usually, the initial accuracy will be moderate but will improve rapidly over time.

- **Where are U**

Send a query SMS to another mobile phone installed with Navfone or other software/system embedded with GPRX. The queried mobile phone will automatically reply its location via SMS also. This location will be cleverly plotted on the Navfone map view as a new favourite.

1. Tap **More > Where are U**
2. To select a mobile number from the address book, tap **Mobile Number**.
3. To enter a mobile number directly, tap on the text box and input the number. Tap **Done** upon completion.
4. Tap **Send**.
5. Wait for a reply SMS from the mobile number.
6. Location of the queried phone will be plotted on the map as a new favourite.

- **Visibility**

Allow or disallow Navfone to be located by other Navfone users.

1. Tap **More > Where is ... > Visibility**
2. Check the Visible option to allow yourself to be located by other Navfone users.
3. Check the Invisible option to deny others the ability to locate you.

- **View SMS Log**

Store a log of SMS query from other Navfone users. The date/time and mobile number of the other party initiating the query will be logged.

2.6 Map

- **Load Map**

Load cities or countries map to the program.

7. Tap **More > Map > Load Map**
8. A file dialog box will be displayed with a list of cities or countries and their respective map layers.
9. Tap the city or country to be loaded.
10. Tap on the checkbox to tick the map layer to be loaded.
11. To select all map layers, tap on any of the map layer, then tap **More > Mark All**. This action will result in all the map layers being selected. You can unselect all the map layers by tapping on **Unmark All**.
12. To start the loading of map, tap the **Load** button.

- **Unload Map**

Unload map layer from the program.

1. Tap **More > Map > Load Map**
2. A file dialog box will be displayed with a list of cities or countries and their respective map layers.
3. Tap on the checkbox to uncheck the map layer to be unloaded.
4. To select all map layers, tap on any of the map layer, then tap **More > Unmark All**. This action will result in all the map layers being unchecked.
5. To continue, tap the **Load** button.

2.7 Favourites

- **Favourites > Create**

There are four methods to create a favourite.

First Method

1. Use the **Search** function. In the list of results, select an item, tap **More > Create favourite**.

Second Method

1. Hold the stylus over a position on the map window for a second.
2. Select **Create favourite** from the pop-up menu and a new favourite will be created with a default icon.
3. Tap **More > Favourites** button to edit the favourites.

Third Method

1. Use the **What's Nearby** function. In the list of results, select an item, tap **More > Create favourite**.

Fourth Method

1. Use the **Where are U** function. The returned location of the queried mobile device will displayed as a favourite.

Note:

The favourite will only be visible at certain scale. This is to avoid clustering of favourite icons on the map.

A favourite created via Search, What's Nearby and Where are U will have a default visibility at zoom scale of 186m or less. Beyond this scale, the icon will not be visible.

A favourite created during map menu will be visible at the scale when it was created.

- **Favourites > Map**

View the location of the selected favourite on the map.

- **Favourites > Edit**

Edit the name of favourite, change icon and add notes to favourite.

1. Tap the **More > Favourites** button.
 2. Select the favourite to be edited.
 3. Edit the name of the favourite from the text box.
 4. Select the icon from the list.
 5. User can also add notes at the text area.
-

- **Favourites > More > Set as Start / Destination**

Select the favourite to be the start/destination.

1. Tap the **Favourites** button.
 2. Select the favourite of interest.
 3. Tap the **More > Set as Start/Destination**.
-

- **Favourites > More > Backup Favourites**

Backup your the favourites before performing firmware upgrade of your phone or reinstallation of the Navfone Pro software.

1. Tap the **Favourites > More > Backup Favourites**.
 2. Enter the favourites file name to save as.
 3. Tap the **Save in** to choose the path on the phone or memory stick.
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- **Favourites > More > Restore Favourites**

Restore your the favourites from your backup after performing a reinstallation of the Navfone Pro software.

1. Tap the **Favourites > More > Restore Favourites**.
 2. Browse to the favourites file and tap **Open**.
-

- **Favourites > More > Send Position**

Share the favourite location with another Navfone user via SMS. The other Navfone user need to have the Navfone software running.

1. Tap the **Favourites > More > Send Position**.
 2. To select a mobile number from the address book, tap **Mobile Number**.
 3. To enter a mobile number directly, tap on the text box and input the number. Tap **Done** upon completion.
 4. Tap **Send**.
-

- **Favourites > More > Delete**

Delete individual favourite.

1. Tap the **Favourites** button.
2. Select the favourite to be deleted.
3. Tap the **Delete** button.

2.8 About

- **Version**

Display software version.

1. Tap **More > About**. Tap on the **Version** tab.
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- **Function**

Display a short description of each function.

2. Tap **More > About**. Tap on the **Function** tab.
