## 2.0 NAVIGATION MENU



<b>WORK</b>	<i>Direct route to a preset Work address</i>
<b>HOME</b>	<i>Direct route to a preset Home address</i>
<b>SEARCH</b>	<i>Search for locations based on address or points-of-interest (POI)</i>
<b>YELLOW PAGES</b>	<i>Search via Yellow Pages Singapore listings</i>
<b>FAVOURITES</b>	<i>Manage stored favourite points</i>
<b>SYSTEM</b>	<i>Configure system settings</i>
<b>TO MAP</b>	<i>View Navigation Map</i>
<b>EXIT</b>	<i>Exit to</i>

Upon starting your system, the main menu (as shown above) would be displayed. The main menu allows you access the respective functions available.

- Tap on one of the following buttons to access your desired tools/functions.

### 2.1 CONFIGURING YOUR SYSTEM



To get the best experience, you could configure your navigation system according to your preference.

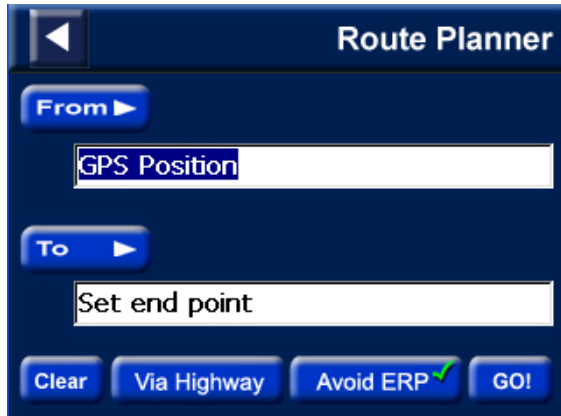
- Tap on the '**System**' button on the Main Menu to access the System Settings menu.
- Tap on any of the buttons to access the respective configurations.







### 3.0 PLANNING YOUR JOURNEY

- Tap on the  **System** button in the main menu.
- Tap on the  **Planner** button in the System Setting menu to launch the Route Planner.



 <b>Via Highway</b>	<i>Routing via the Highways &amp; Expressway</i>
 <b>Shortest Dist</b>	<i>Routing via Main Road</i>
 <b>Avoid ERP</b> 	<i>Allow routes where ERP are in operation.</i>
 <b>Avoid ERP</b> 	<i>Avoids routes where ERP are in operation.</i>

#### 3.1 SETTING YOUR POINTS

- Tap the '**From**' button to select and set your start point. Similarly, tap the '**To**' button to select and set your end point. By default, your start point would be set to your current location (i.e. the GPS position).
- The subsequent screen allows you to select from the list of favorite points stored. Alternatively, you can select from a list of recent end points or carry out a location search and select one of the locations as your desired point.



Alternatively, you may select '**GPS**' to set your current location as your Start Point or you may select from the list of favorite points.



#### 3.2 SEARCH FOR THE LOCATION

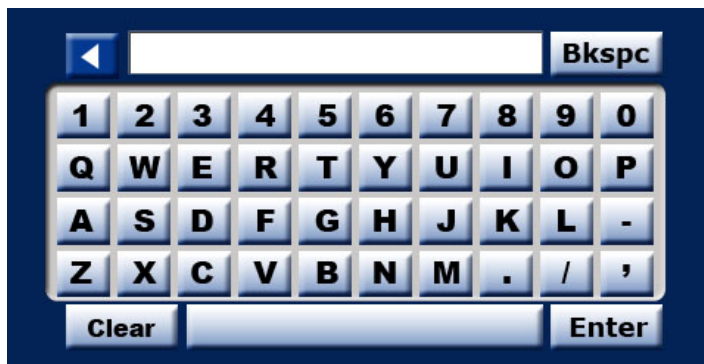
- Tap on the '**Search**' button to search for the desired location and set it as your End Point (or Start Point).

- The subsequent screen allows you to select the layer to search. It is recommended to search a specific search layer rather than all the layers. (Refer to the List of General Search Layers)



The search tool also allows you to search a specific layer (such as Building). For countries with many states such as Malaysia, users would be required to select a desired state to search or they can search all the states.

A generic keyboard would then be launch for you to enter your search keyword. You may enter a location name or postal code.



- Enter your desired keyword by pressing the alphabet keys. (e.g. Bishan Ju...)
- Tap on the '**Enter**' button to proceed with your search. The search tool shall start the search process and display the results in the Search Results panel.



As the Search Results would display a maximum of 50 matched locations, it is advisable to enter a more specific keyword rather than a generic keyword.

### 3.3 USING YOUR SEARCH RESULTS

- Upon successful search, the results would be displayed in the Search Results panel.
- With the results, you can select the desired location and tap on any of the buttons to carry out the respective actions.



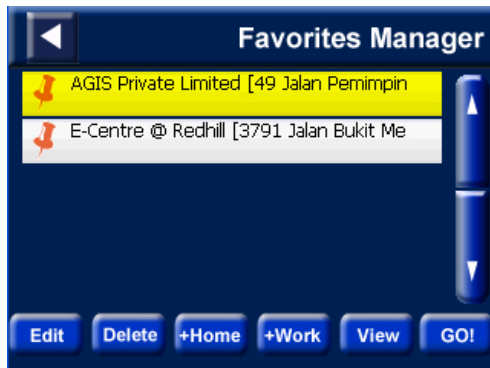
- Tap on **'+End'** to set your selected location as your End Point. The Start Point could be set similarly if you do not want to start routing from your current GPS location.
- You will be brought back to Planner.

<b>View</b>	View the selected location
<b>+End</b>	Set location as End Point
<b>+Start</b>	Set location as Start Point
<b>+Fav</b>	Add location to Favorite list
<b>Nearby</b>	Search for nearby amenities
<b>GO!</b>	Go directly to navigation map with the selected location as the End Point.

### 3.4 ROUTING TO YOUR DESTINATION

- Tap on **GO!** to start the routing. Otherwise, tap on **Clear** to clear your existing route.
- Upon successful routing, the system would lead you to the navigation map and you are on way to your destination.

## 4.0 MANAGING YOUR FAVORITES



<b>Edit</b>	Edit the name of the selected favourite
<b>Delete</b>	Remove the selected favourite
<b>+Home</b>	Set the selected favourite as Home preset location
<b>+Work</b>	Set the selected favourite as Work preset location
<b>View</b>	View the selected favourite
<b>GO!</b>	Go directly to navigation map with the selected location as the End Point.

Favorites Manager helps you to save that frequently visited location or an interesting place you've have just visited.

- Tap on the '**Favorites**' button to launch the Favorite Manager

Your favorite points would be listed in the display.

### 4.1 ADDING A NEW FAVORITE POINT

Favorite points could be added via a location search or from the navigation map while on navigation.

#### 4.2 BY A LOCATION SEARCH:

1. Proceed with searching for desired location.
2. From the search results display, select the desired location and tap '**+Fav**' to add the location to your favorite list,



#### 4.3 MARK FAVORITE ON THE MAP:

1. In the navigation map, tap on the '**Q-Menu**' button to activate the quick menu.
2. From this quick menu, tap on the '**Mark Fav**' button. The current GPS location on the map would be marked as a favorite location.

#### 4.4 SETTING A FAVORITE POINT AS A PRESET


You can set your favourite point as a preset Work or Home address. With this preset, you could route directly to the address from your current GPS location by clicking on the 'Home' or 'Work' button in the main menu.

1. Select the desired location from the favorite list.
2. Tap on '**+Work**' or '**+Home**' to set the location as your preset. The Work preset would

be denoted by a  icon while the Home preset would be denoted by a  icon.

## 5.0 KNOW YOUR MAP

With a quick access menu, you can have the ease of carrying out simple tasks on the go.

- Tap on the  button in the Main Menu to go to the Navigation Map. You will also launch the Navigation Map upon starting your route from the Planner screen.

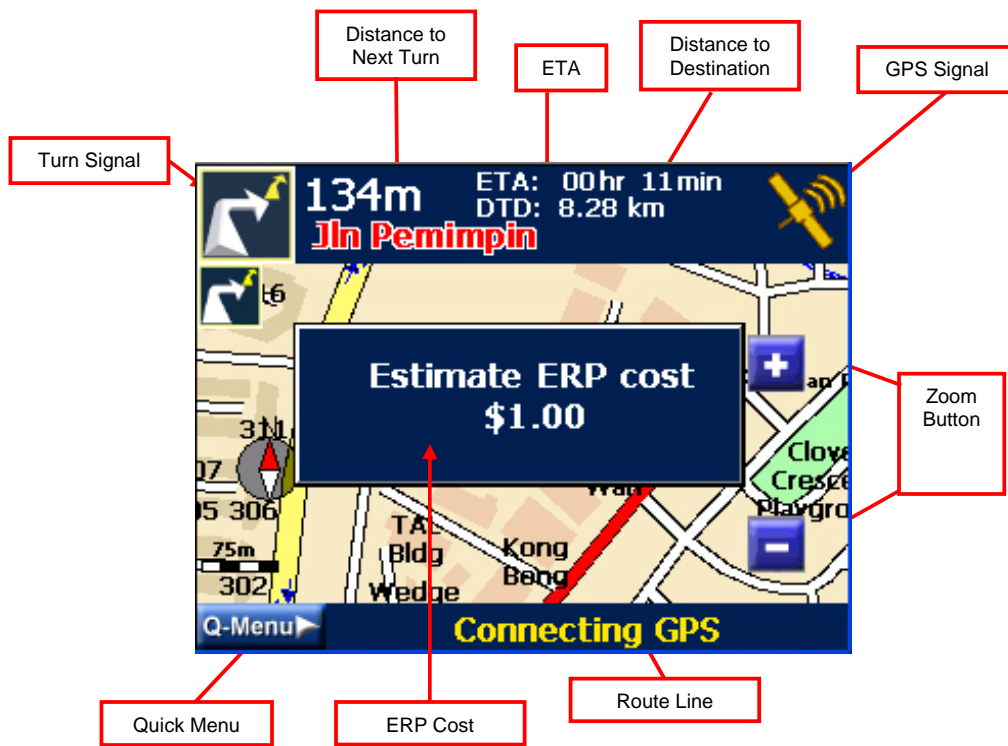
### 5.1 QUICK MENU (Q-Menu)

The quick menu is a quick access menu to allow users to carry out certain actions on-the-go. To launch the quick menu, tap on the Q-Menu button.

- Tap on the following buttons to carry out the respective actions.

<b>Menu</b>	Return to the main menu
<b>2-D / 3-D</b>	Switch between 2D and 3D navigation view
<b>Mark Fav</b>	Mark current location as a favorite point
<b>Prompt</b>	Re-play the most recent navigation prompt
<b>More / Back</b>	To view more / less of the quick menu
<b>Nearby</b>	Search for nearby amenities
<b>Simulate</b>	Simulate t planned route

### 5.2 NAVIGATION MAP



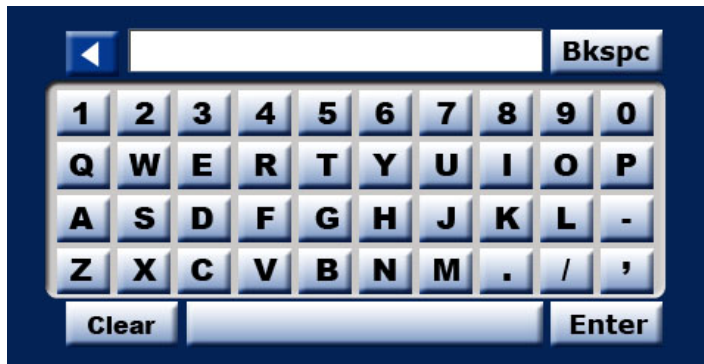
<b>Turn Signal</b>	<i>Shows the next turn that you are to make.</i>
<b>Distance to Next Turn</b>	<i>Distance to the next turn that you are going to make.</i>
<b>ETA</b>	<i>Estimated time of arrival at the destination.</i>
<b>Distance to Destination</b>	<i>Estimated distance remaining to destination.</i>
<b>GPS Signal</b>	<i>Color indicates if GPS signal is present or absent. Tap the icon to view a detailed GPS status.</i>
<b>Zoom Button</b>	<i>Tap to zoom in or out.</i>
<b>Route Line</b>	<i>The route that you are going to travel.</i>
<b>Navigation Arrow</b>	<i>Points to the direction of travel.</i>
<b>Current Road</b>	<i>Name of road you currently traveling on.</i>
<b>North Compass</b>	<i>The North compass pointing towards the north direction.</i>
<b>Est. ERP Cost</b>	<i>Displays the estimated ERP cost.</i>

## 6.0 YELLOW PAGES SEARCH

- Tap on the  button in the main menu.



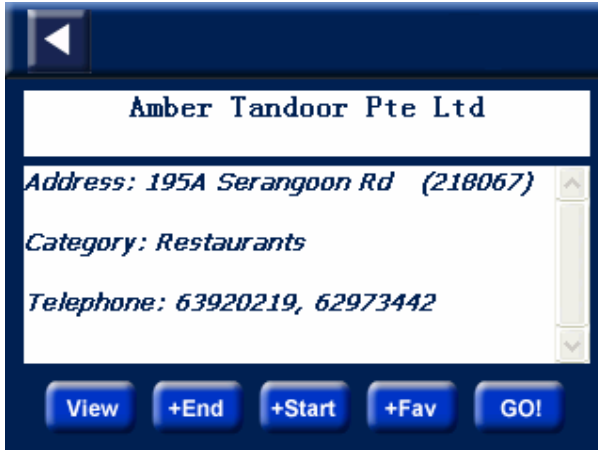
- Select "Search All" or a specific category.



- Key in the search keyword.



- Select a result



<b>View</b>	View the selected location
<b>+End</b>	Set location as End Point
<b>+Start</b>	Set location as Start Point
<b>+Fav</b>	Add location to Favorite list
<b>GO!</b>	Go directly to navigation map with the selected location as the End Point.

Shopping	Shopping and marketing amenities: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>♦ Shopping centres and malls</li> <li>♦ Supermarkets and markets</li> <li>♦ Neighbourhood shops</li> </ul>
Entertainment & Recreation	Entertainment and recreational facilities: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>♦ Night entertainment spots</li> <li>♦ Art and performance venues (such as cinemas and theatres)</li> <li>♦ Sports and recreational facilities</li> <li>♦ Recreational spaces (such as parks, gardens, golf courses)</li> </ul>

Hotel & Resorts	Temporary lodgings: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>♦ Hotels, motels and (budget) hostels</li> <li>♦ Dormitories</li> </ul>
<b>Emergency Services</b>	
Medical	Medical services including veterinarians
Police & Fire Rescue	Non-medical emergency services: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>♦ Police posts, stations and centres</li> <li>♦ Fire posts, stations and centres</li> </ul>

Transport	Transport amenities and infrastructures: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>♦ Bus stops, interchanges and depots</li> <li>♦ Rail and train facilities</li> <li>♦ Airport and sea ports (including harbour, jetty etc)</li> <li>♦ Transport payment gantries (such as ERP, toll)</li> </ul>
Automobile (Car)	Automobile services such as: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>♦ Automobile workshops and service centres</li> <li>♦ Car rental centres</li> <li>♦ Car show rooms and dealers</li> </ul>
